

**Blumfield Township**  
Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes  
November 13, 2018

Supervisor Reinbold called the meeting to order at 7:30pm with all board members present.

Frahm moved to approve the October regular meeting minutes as presented. Huber supported. Motion carried.

**Supervisor** – The Sheriff Dept. is asking for information regarding water access to be placed on GIS for disaster issues. Supervisor will direct them to the Water Authority.

**Road Advisory** – Road Commission has projected the bridge project on Beyer Rd to cost \$85,000. A preliminary road budget was presented.

**Construction Code** – 5 Building, 6 Electrical, 2 Electrical, 2 Mechanical, and 1 Plumbing permits were issued in October.

**Planning Commission** – Site Plan for Hirschman Oil's office building was approved.

**Fire Chief** – reported 1 PI, 1 Brush fire, and 1 Disregard runs for October. Training was Search and Rescue and Operations. The 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Trunk or Treat event was very successful. Thank you to all that participated.

Reese – reported 2 PI and 1 Medical runs for October.

**Water Authority** – Water tower painting is not complete.

**Treasurer** – Getting ready for winter tax notices.

**Clerk** – November 6, 2018 election went fairly smoothly. Blumfield has a 70% turnout. Financial Statement is available.

**Trustees** – Huber filled additional pot holes in the cemetery driveway and will be replacing many light bulbs in the office. Frahm had water lines in the cemetery blew out.

Roethlisberger presented request from Roger Goslin for cemetery lots. The Board would like to have more information before deciding on this request.

Frahm moved to approve presented check register 25387-25428, payroll and monthly EFT's. Huber supported. Motion carried.
